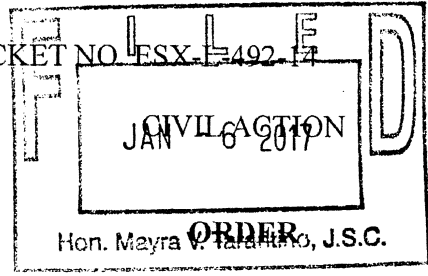

ORDERED that all documents ~~relating to Mr. Carlsen's membership, application, or affiliation with the Board of Certified Safety Professionals, including but not~~


